Tips for: printing, format and use

Printing:

- ☞ We recommend to use Adobe Reader and follow the printing instructions. We suggest you print 4 or 6 cards per page.

Format:

- ☞ If you wish to take the cards along on your journey and use them intensively, a good solution is to put each of them in a plastic cover.
- ☞ You can also turn the cards into a booklet and take it along wrapped in a plastic bag.
- ☞ Tip: give such a hand-made set away as a present to someone who sets out on his/her pilgrimage.

Use:

- ☞ We have presented the cards in a certain order: the call, departure etc.. Although numbered, the order of the cards is almost at random within these chapters. You may follow the given order, but you can also arrange them in your own special way.
- ☞ Whenever the word "walking" is used on the cards, we also mean "cycling" of course.
- ☞ Start every (walking or cycling) day with one card and take it along in mind. In the evening write down your insights in your diary.
- ☞ Alternatively ...offer another pilgrim to pull out a card from the stack and start a conversation and/or even better give this card away.
- ☞ Why not ... for instance in the *albergue* in the evening, use the cards together with other pilgrims. Everyone will draw a card. Then you tell each other what your thoughts are. Leave everyone in his own value, just listen, ask some more questions if you want to, but do not judge. There is not just one "right" answer. Everyone has his/her own story.
- ☞ Or Undoubtedly you will find another good way which appeals to you, to use the cards.
